Gentlemen:

We acknowledge receipt of your email dated 31 December 2019, together with your duly accomplished and signed QCAA Form 16, FAR Part-145 Air Agency Certificate Ref: O2RR414Y, Letter of Intent (LOI) from Qatar Airways Group Q.C.S.C., proposed QCAA MOE Supplement and other supporting documents.

We wish to inform you that based on the above and your held FAR Part-145 Air Agency Certificate Ref: O2RR414Y, a QCAR 1003/2006 Article 7 Certificate of Acceptance Ref: QCAA/FAMO/245 is hereby issued to your organization in pursuance to State Law No. 15 of 2002, effective 02 January 2020. However, as a holder of the certificate, your organization will be audited by this Authority. Pursuant to Article (40), Chapter 7 of Law 15 of 2002 and State of Qatar Human Resources Law No. 15 of 2016 and Council of Ministers Decision No. 32 of 2016, all cost associated with the audit shall be borne by your organization consisting of the payment for the services of the QCAA Audit Team and round-trip airline tickets for the auditors.

It is a condition to this approval, however, that the continuous validity of your held QCAR 1003/2006 Article 7 Certificate of Acceptance is subject to the satisfactory validation and final approval of your proposed QCAA MOE Supplement and result of the requisite QCAA audit at the approved location of your operation. This Authority may restrict, suspend, withdraw or revoke the approval should the organization fail to meet or comply with applicable requirements and established procedures or refrain from facilitating the conduct of inspection by the authorized inspectors, in pursuance to Article (40) of Law 15 of 2002. Pending final approval of your proposed QCAA MOE Supplement dated 30 December 2019, the same is hereby provisionally approved for your implementation.
